

To Filter Spam E-mails using Outlook

- 1. On the **Tools** menu, click on **Rules Wizard**.
- 2. Click on the **New** button.
- 3. Which type of rule do you want to create?: Move messages based on content.
- 4. Rule Description: click on specific words.
- 5. Type [SPAM Note: must be typed exactly as shown, All Caps, Square Bracket, No Spaces.
- 6. Click on the **ADD** button then **OK**.
- 7. Next click on specified folder.
- 8. Click on the New button. Name the folder you want the Spam e-mail to go (i.e. Spam). Click OK.

To Filter Spam E-mails using Outlook Express

- 1. On the Tools menu, point to Message Rules, and then click Mail.
- 2. If this is the first rule you are creating, proceed to step 3. Otherwise, on the Mail Rules tab, click **New**.
- 3. Select the Conditions for your rule: Where the subject line contains specific words.
- 4. Select the Actions for your rule: Move it to the specified folder.
- 5. Rule Description: Click on contains specific words.
- 6. Type [SPAM Note: must be typed exactly as shown, All Caps, Square Bracket, No Spaces.
- 7. Click on the **ADD** button then **OK**.
- 8. Next click on specified folder.
- 9. Click on New Folder. Name the folder you want the Spam e-mail to go (i.e. Spam). Click OK.
- 10. In the Name of the rule box, select the default name, type a new name for your rule, and click OK.

To Filter Spam E-mails using Netscape Messenger

- 1. On the Edit menu, click on Message Filters.
- 2. Filters for: **Inbox**.
- 3. Click on the **New** button.
- 4. Filter Name: **Spam**.
- 5. Click in the circle for **Match any of the following**.
- 6. The <u>subject</u> of the message <u>contains</u>: Type [SPAM Note: must be typed exactly as shown, All Caps, Square Bracket, No Spaces.
- 7. Then move to folder, click on New Folder. Name the folder you want the Spam e-mail to go (i.e. Spam).
- 8. Click **OK**.
